SUMMER HIGHLIGHTS: EARN-A-BIKE A SUCCESS FOR ANOTHER YEAR

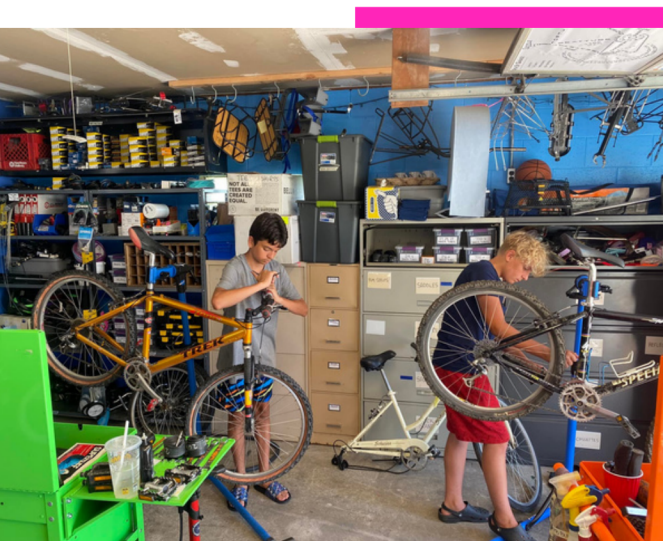


EARN-A-BIKE: BRINGING OPERATIONAL BIKES AND PRIDE OF OWNERSHIP TO AREA YOUTH

2022 is our first year offering Mobile Bike Repair, a program sponsored by and in partnership with WI Bike Fed and the City of Green Bay. The launch was a success — we served over 50 Green Bay youth and cyclists and got noticed by Governor Evers! The program enables us to offer basic bike repair services that help residents have access to operational bikes and keep enjoying a good hobby and sustainable transportation.
